Purpose: Train and certify SMART trainers and coaches to build sustainable internal capacity for applying an aligned, systematic approach to goal-setting, progress monitoring, and continuous improvement at the school level; support a SMART Goal-driven process of principal and teacher effectiveness and student achievement.

Format: Starting in September, a new cohort of Academy district teams will learn how to coach the proven-effective, data-driven SMART School Improvement Process. Your Academy team members will be supported by a personal Master SMART Coach as they work with a school-based team. Reflecting best practice in professional learning, the Academy includes 8 days of training, 4 team SMART coaching sessions, and a dedicated online collaborative space.

Training dates: September 11 & 12, October 29 & 30, December 3 & 4, April 7 & 8 Training will occur at National Louis University – 850 Warrenville Road in Lisle, IL 60532.

Benefits: Your Academy team members will receive 2 books, PowerPoints, instructor guide, participant manual and a coaching style inventory. They will have access to updates of tools, training modules, videos, and other support as members of the SMART School Network.

Cost: \$3200 per participant. The Academy is limited in size to accommodate a deeper and more personalized learning experience for you and your team, with the objective of building your district's internal capacity. As a result, your Academy team must include two or more members.
