Isolate Need (Affinity Activity)

Purpose: Isolate perceptions of children's learning needs **Outcome:** Documented perceptions and assumptions

Material(s): Sticky notes; sticky dots; chart paper and markers

Instructions:

- 1. Select roles facilitator, timekeeper, and scribe. (1 minute)
- 2. Review your mission and why it is important to understand perceptions of children's learning needs. (1 minute)
- 3. Individually brainstorm answers to the presenting question, using one sticky note per idea. (3 minutes)

Presenting Question: Which academic areas, standards or skills have our children struggled with most over the past several years?

- 4. As a team, silently group sticky notes together on the chart paper provided. Name the categories. (8 minutes)
- 5. Individuals multivote using sticky dots to prioritize the categories of children's learning needs. (5 minutes)
- 6. Document the priority affinity categories. Discuss what we need to know and how we will find out. (10 minutes)
- 7. Evaluate your meeting what worked well? (2 minutes)
